## Pastor's Corner

**"You are the light of the world; a city set on a hill cannot be hidden; nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all that are in the house. Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven." Matt. 5:14-16**

If we are the light of the world, are we shining into the world with such brightness that others see the glory and power of God more today than any other time in history? I think so on a global level, but, I ask, how about in Southern Utah?

In John 6:28-29, The disciples ask; **"What shall we do, so that we may work the works of God."** Jesus answers them and says; **"This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent."**

Jesus says in Matthew **"Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works,..."** If we are to do good works, it has nothing to do with our own skills, will or desire. It has everything to do with God and His desires for our lives and communities.

In Acts 10:38 it reads: **"You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."** Here is a clear example of "doing good Works." Jesus is the ultimate example of how we are to be in our daily lives. When we move in the same manner as our Lord, our light will shine so bright that our neighbors, those in our work places, schools and our fellow lovers of Christ will desire what the Lord has given us.

If we let the light of God permeate us and we walk with His light illuminating our way, we should have a hard time stumbling or falling, and we can help guide others to the Source of the light. Let's let God's light shine in us and through us, then people will see the glory of God!

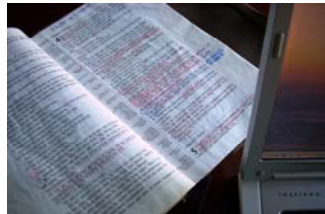
### Tuesday Night Bible Study

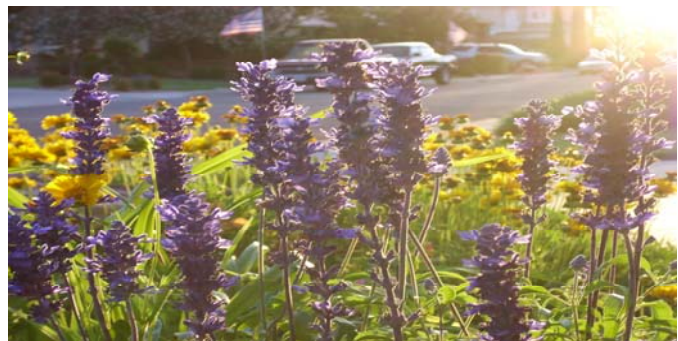
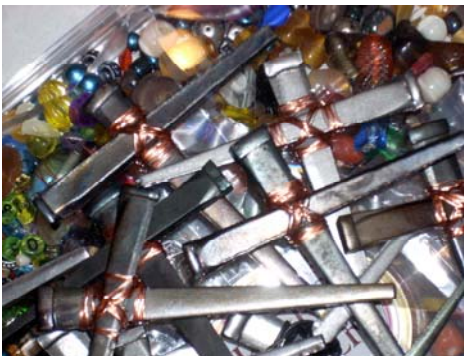
